The main research objective of is to study the molecular mechanisms of the alcohol actions in the adult and developing brain, within research project funded by Plan Nacional sobre Drogas (Ministerio de Sanidad, PNSD 2018 I003) on the role of the immune system and the TLR4 receptors response in the effects of alcohol during adolescence

The person who is incorporated will be in charge of maintaining colony of mice ( WT and TLR4-KO with and without ethanol intake), to performed primary culture of glial and neuronal cells and to collaborate with the students and personnel of the laboratory, following the guidelines of the Chief of laboratory.
